Then based on these theological roots the Qur'an reveals all aspects that make it easier for humans. In the Qur'an the mind or comes from Arabic, namely 'aql. A human being is born with the nature of 'aql to think. Then aql in Indonesian has the meaning as a tool for thinking, mind or memory. (Poerwardawinta, 2007). And then reason ('aql can be used as the thinking power that exists within a person and while the thinking power is one of them is thinking, understanding and understanding. (Ensiklopedia, 2005).

'Aql is found at least 49 times in the Koran as for example found in (ta'qilun in QS al-Baqarah: 44, Ya'qilun in QS Furqan: 44 and Yasin: 68) Naqilu in QS Mulk; 10, Yaqiluha 9Q.S. Al-Ankabut: 43), aqaluhu in QS al-Baqarah; 20) and of course there are several words that indicate other meanings of thinking contained in the Qur'an

Mindset in the study of psychology consists of two types namelygrowth mindset(development mindset and fixed mindset). (Dweck, 2006). Growth if taken from the English dictionary means growth, development. So a growth mindset is a developing mindset. In the context of education growth mindset is

a basic potential in achieving learning success, because people who have a growth mindset are people who believe that their abilities and intelligence can continue to develop and grow. Thus, a growth mindset is one that is based on belief in the basic qualities that exist within a person which are things that can be cultivated through certain efforts.

Of course it's not easy to dotrain students to be able to understand the concept of growth mindset. But to be able to grow and build growth in a person by practicing self-habitation in managing emotions. There are several aspects of the growth mindset, namely (1) belief in intelligence, talent and character that can be developed, (2) belief that challenges or difficulties and failures are important for self-development, (3) belief that effort and hard work contribute to success, (4) belief criticism and input from other people bait success. The method does not only function as a method but the method in Islamic education must be able to have several functions such as for example it must be able to stimulate students' thinking processes, make it easier for students to understand the material being taught and must also be used as an alternative to provide a more focused appreciation of the material being studied. Regarding the method, there are several methods that can be drawn from the Koran related to methods.

## (1)Story And Lecture Method

The story method is the most classic method, but it is still relevant today even by adding certain techniques. MethodLectures are known as a form of learning with a learning model that takes place by providing descriptions and explanations to students at a certain time and place.(Drajat, 2004). Allah provides information regarding the method contained in Q.S. Al-Kahfi:66-67

It means:" Musa said to him (Khidhr), " may I follow you so that you teach me (true knowledge) that has been taught to you (to be) guidance /" He replied really you would not be able to be patient with me. How can you be patient with something of which you do not have enough knowledge about it. (QS Al-Kahf) (Tim Al-Qoshbah, 2022).

Based on the message of the Koran in the word above suggests several meanings that can be madea basis in determining the learning method. The story between Musa and Khidr provides an explanation that in teaching students to study, they must be able to awaken students to intentions and patience. The above words also have meaning about how students behave with their educators and how educators inspire students' intentions or foundations. (Ar-Rifai, 2012).

The meaning of this interpretation is also in line with the meaning that the dialogue is an ideal model in an educative context between educators and students who have ethical requirements.and tenderness. (Az-Zuhaili, 2005). Besides that, it is implied how serious he is in studying knowledge which is illustrated from the dialogue in the word. (Shihab, 2002).

(2) Methods of Discussion, Questions and Answers or Dialogue In QS Al-Anbiya verse 7:

It means: We did not send messengers before you (Muhammad), but men whom We gave revelations to them, so ask those who are knowledgeable, if you do not know." (QS al-Anbiya (21): 7) (Tim Al-Qoshbah, 2022).

The special dialogue above indicates that there is a discussion or questionanswer one question. The verse above implies about asking questions and by asking someone knows more about what he doesn't know (Tafsir Ibnu Katsir).

(3) Awareness Method In QS Luqman (31): 13)

It means: "And (remember) when Luqman said to his son, when he taught his son a lesson," O my son! Do not associate partners with Allah, in fact associating (Allah) is truly a great injustice. (QS Luqman (31):13) (Tim Al-Qoshbah, 2022).

The word of God above is a simple example that is full of meaning where there is a message that reminds and teaches something good and leaves bad. Universally education is an effort to prevent and make students aware of something that is prohibited in religion and to remind them to do noble things for the good of the world and the hereafter. Luqman's willabove are the mess ages and advice given to their children to obey the commands of Allah SWT and forbid what is wrong. (Al-Qurthubi, 2009).In the learning process it is very

important to emphasize what is prohibited and do what is good, so that awareness is one of the effective methods in learning Islamic education. (Shihab, 2002).

# (4) Exemplary Method

The word in the verse above is very well known in the world of education that suggests that the ideal model is the Prophet Muhammad. In the word above also implies that as an educator must also be the Prophet Muhammad to be an example so that he will be able to be an example. The main points of the commandments contained in the word above are both in words, deeds and circumstances, therefore Allah commands humans to emulate the patience, firmness and sincerity of the Prophet Muhammad. ## 2. METHODS
