Analysis of Interest in Implementing Halal Certification Among MSMEs In Medan City

ABSTRACT

To support the progress of their business, MSMEs must carry out halal certification, which is issued by the government. Halal certification also offers new opportunities for economic growth and development, especially in the halal food industry. The aim of this research is to provide broader knowledge to MSMEs who do not yet have halal certificates for food and beverage products, that halal certificates have a big influence on business progress because they create a sense of confidence in consumers towards halal drinks and food. The research method used is a quantitative method by asking questions in the form of a questionnaire generally using a Likert scale (Scale 1-5 (strongly disagree - strongly agree). The conclusion obtained from the research results is that it was found that there is still a lack of knowledge in MSMEs about halal certification However, these MSMEs have the desire to apply for halal certification.

1. INTRODUCTION

Currently in Indonesia, where the majority of people are Muslim, halal certification has become mandatory. To ensure that food and drinks are halal for consumption, composition and production aspects must be considered when distributing food and drinks. One of the opportunities for new economic growth is the halal food industry. As a result, the Indonesian government is trying to develop the halal food and beverage industry in its country. First, an in-depth understanding of the procedures for implementing halal certification is required.

Halal certification ensures that materials, production processes and halal guarantee systems meet the standards of the Indonesian Ulema Council's Food, Medicine and Cosmetics Assessment Institute (LPPOM MUI). With halal certification, consumers can feel safe when using goods. Customers' beliefs about product quality greatly influence the number of products they buy.

To accelerate the implementation of halal standards in Indonesia, Law Number 33 of 2014 concerning product guarantees stipulates that halal product certification is mandatory. If pagan businesses in Indonesia must obtain halal certification to sell them, it means that the food is halal for Muslims. Explanation of the Law: The law emphasizes that halal information is very important for the majority of Muslims in Indonesia.

A study of the halal food and beverage certification process in the city of Medan found that there were several problems that hampered the halal certification process. One of them is the limit of authority and income of the Indonesian Ulema Council (LP – POM) to carry out halal outreach. Business actors do not realize the importance of maintaining the halalness of the food and beverage products they sell. Apart from that, the Muslim community does not understand the importance of paying attention to the halalness of the food or drink products consumed.

Small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) are an important part of the Indonesian economy. MSMEs are a type of productive business owned by an individual or business entity, usually engaged in the trade sector with certain characteristics. Apart from making a major contribution to the country's economic growth, MSMEs also offer many job opportunities to the Indonesian people. because this can help small and medium businesses (MSMEs) learn more about the importance of halal certification for their products so that customers feel comfortable when consuming food and drinks.

The aim of the researcher in conducting this research is because there are still many MSMEs in the city of Medan that have not carried out the halal certification process for their products, therefore the researcher wants to know how interested MSME traders are in implementing halal certification on their products.

2. METHOD

This research uses quantitative methods. This method relies on concrete data; This data is in the form of numbers that will be measured using statistics to test considerations related to the problem being studied. In this research, a questionnaire was used to collect data. The questionnaire was distributed to respondents by asking several lists of questions related to halal certification. MSME traders who sell on Jl. William Iskandar Ps. V, Medan Estate, District. Percut Sei Tuan, Deli Serdang Regency, and the population in this study on Jl. Brigadier General H.A Manaf Lubis, Central Helvetia, District. Helvetia Field.

3. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

a. MSME Data

Data was obtained on 35 MSME traders who did not yet have halal certificates for the food and beverage products they sold. The following is a list of 35 MSME trader data.



After the data was collected, MSME traders were asked to fill out a questionnaire provided by researchers to find out their views on halal certification. Questions asked to MSME owners using questionnaires generally use a Likert scale (scale 1 – 5 (strongly disagree – strongly agree)).

b. Get to know the term Halal Certification

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan can be determined through the graph below.




Graph 1. Knowledge of halal certification terms

Two questions were asked to MSME traders about their knowledge regarding halal certification, namely (1) I know the term halal certification, (2) I do not know the term halal certification. It was obtained that 100% of the answers given by respondents were that they knew the term halal certification.

a) Know about BPJPH?

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan about BPJPH can be seen through the graph below




Graph 2. Knowledge about BPJPH

Two choices were given to answer questions asked to MSME traders about their knowledge of BPJPH, namely (1) yes and (2) no. It was obtained 30.6% for the yes points and 69.4% for the no points, which means that 11 MSMEs knew about BPJPH and 25 MSMEs did not know about BPJPH. Which means there is a need to provide outreach to MSMEs about what BPJPH is.

b) What do you think about obtaining halal certification at MUI?

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the opinions of MSME traders in the city of Medan regarding processing halal certification at the MUI can be seen through the graph below.

Two choices were given to answer the questions given to MSMEs, namely yes and no. 63.9% of yes points were obtained and 36.1% of no points were obtained. This means that as many as 23 MSMEs think that processing halal certification is at MUI and as many as 12 MSMEs think that processing halal certification is not at MUI.

c) Do you think the halal certification process is the same as the BPOM certification process?

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan can be seen through the graph below




Graph 4. The assumption that the halal certification process is the same as the BPOM certification process

Two choices were given to answer the questions given to MSMEs, namely yes and no. It was 56.6% for the yes choice and 44.4% for the no choice. This means that as many as 20 MSMEs think that the halal certification process is the same as the BPOM certification process and as many as 15 MSMEs do not consider the halal certification process to be the same as the BPOM certification process.

d) Knowledge of halal certification


Grafik 5. pengetahuan tentang sertifikasi halal

The results obtained were 0% strongly disagreed, 8.3% disagreed, 22.2% were unsure, 38.9% agreed, and 30.6% strongly agreed. Which means that there are 0 MSMEs who are completely unaware of halal certification, 3 MSMEs who are not very aware of halal certification, 8 MSMEs who are unsure about their knowledge of halal certification, 14 MSMEs who are aware of halal certification, and 11 MSMEs who are very knowledgeable about halal certification.

a) Knowledge that halal certification is the process of obtaining a halal certificate as proof that the ingredients and production process of my business are in accordance with the halal guarantee system based on the provisions of the Indonesian Ulema Council's Food, Drug and Cosmetic Study Institute (LPPOM MUI)


Graph 9. Awareness of the many benefits if a product is halal certified

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan can be seen through the graph below




Graph 13. MSME knowledge about the requirements for applying for halal certification


Graph 14. Awareness that halal certification is necessary




Graph 15. Awareness of processing halal certification for products

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan can be seen through the graph below




Graph 16. Desire to improve the quality of my business production in accordance with LPPOM MUI halal criteria




Graph 19. Difficulty understanding halal procedures

Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan can be seen through the graph below




Graph 20. The halal certification process is long and complicated



Based on the results of a survey conducted in the field by distributing questionnaires, the knowledge of MSME traders in the city of Medan can be seen through the graph below




Graph 24. Intention to start halal certification for business

4. CONCLUSION

The conclusion obtained from the results of research conducted by researchers is that there are still many MSMEs in the city of Medan that do not yet have halal certificates for traded food and beverage products. The lack of socialization has resulted in a lack of knowledge among MSMEs about halal certification. There are many reasons why MSMEs do not carry out halal certification, some of which are the perception that processing halal certification is expensive and lack of knowledge regarding what conditions are needed to obtain halal certification.

However, from the 35 MSMEs who filled out the questionnaire, it was concluded that they agreed to take part in the free halal certification carried out by the government. From this it can be concluded that there is still a willingness among MSMEs to register their products as halal products. However, due to the obstacles that occurred, they gave up their plans. MSMEs hope that the government will make it easier for MSMEs to apply for halal certification. Because MSMEs contribute to the Indonesian economy. MSMEs that have received halal certificates for food and beverage products that they will market to producers will increase sales because of consumer trust in these halal products.
